: Each year 1.4 million children die as a result of poor Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) practices, and millions more suffer long-term consequences. According to the 2007 BDHS, 43% of children under five are stunted or too short for their age. This indicates chronic malnutrition at national level. Exclusive breast feeding is a key to nutrition during early infancy but the situation is very unfortunate in our country. The IYCF practices recommend that breastfed children of age 6-23 months be fed food from three or more other food groups. Less than half (44%) of breastfed children met this recommendations. Other than this, inappropriate and inadequate complementary feeding practices are quite common. Even at age 6-7 months, three in ten breastfed children are not given any solid or semisolid food.

Child nutrition is not a top ranking national priority. Addressing under-nourished children of age 2 years is not seen as an urgent issue. As a result, future of the nation is at risk. To make policy makers keep infant and young child feeding high on public health agenda and obtain proactive support at all levels, advocacy is much needed. The best channels of communication for reaching decision makers are the media. Thus, capacity building of media professionals is also vital. Through this initiative, journalists, by enhancing their capacity, will be able to play a proactive role in drawing policy attentions.
