Background:

Bangladesh experienced a historic student-led uprising and political transition that escalated from protests over public-sector job quotas into a nationwide revolution. State forces responded violently, that caused lives and public properties in July-August 2024, and then the interim government led by Nobel laureate Dr. Muhammad Yunus took power, where the newly found opportunities have triggered passionate arguments and discussions in favour of press freedom and independent journalism. The Project Improving Quality Journalism in Bangladesh-Phase III started the year in a media landscape working under such new socio-political environment.

Bangladesh has a huge number of registered media. Journalism in Bangladesh achieved amazing growth in recent years, and the number of news outlets and journalists have been increased, making it difficult to estimate the numbers accurately. According to the published data of Department of Film and Publication (DFP), under the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, there are 3,346 registered newspapers in Bangladesh till August 2025, of which 710 are enlisted. Number of daily newspapers is 1,394, and 572 are published from Dhaka City. Around 56 television channels including state owned four channels are permitted, of which 36 are currently on air. Other than that, 170 online news portals are publishing news regularly.

In a country with this robust number of news media outlets, there are shortage of skilled manpower including reporters, editors, and news managers, lack of appropriate polices and ownership structures and solid financial strength. The whole industry is also suffering for the shortage of young, trained reporters. The Media Reform Commission formed by the interim government in its report also identified the need for news media accountability through self-regulation and adherence to global best practices.

The project Improving Quality Journalism in Bangladesh is working to empower Bangladeshi news outlets to produce quality reports that hold political and economic power accountable, enhance transparency, governance, democracy, and accountability, and reduce corruption. By focusing on some critical areas such as environment and climate change, gender equality, and poverty, the project seeks to restore public trust in journalism and boost revenue for the media outlets.

Capacity building of journalists and newsrooms is required to improve the quality of journalism in Bangladesh including support and facilitate the production of high-quality, indepth and investigative reports that serve the public interest. The project has implemented the activities this reporting year in a difficult situation due to the unprecedented political turmoil and changing media landscape.

Project period:

Duration of the first year of the project was September 2024-August 2025.

Activities performed:

Phase III of the IQJB project had implemented the capacity building activities to improve the quality of journalism and enhancing internal capacity of the individual journalists and news outlets along with some partnership and advocacy initiatives.

Activity-1: Investigative Journalism Partnership (IJP)

The investigative journalism partnership (IJP) is one of the major initiatives of the project for supporting the news outlets and individual journalists in investigation and capacity building. Under the IJP programme, four partner news outlets have implemented and started

their activities during this year in conducting investigation, capacity-building training and others. Two of the partners have applied for revising their agreements and a another applied for new partnership at the end of the year. A total of 28 stories has been published during the year under different IJ partnerships. Most of the stories published this year are on climate change and the environment, corruption and public interest issues.

One of the leading Bangla dailies have partnered with the project and produced 17 in-depth and investigative stories including series reports on the impact of climate change and the environment in coastal districts, under the supervision of a mentor and also as a part of sustainability they utilize their learning. Before the end of this year, the newspaper has signed a new agreement for implementing in the next year.

One of the regional newspapers signed the partnership to enhance their capacity, producing long form public interest reports and becoming more efficient on online and digital platforms. The project has supported them through capacity assessments, in-house training on investigation on public interest and digital & multimedia reporting to improve their online and social media platforms. They have published 4 stories on public interest issues.

The project has continued its support to one of the leading English dailies under the IJP programme. The newspaper has received support from the project to navigate the digital transformation, build a strong reader base, and establish a sustainable reader revenue model by 2027. They have started to implement the recommendations of the survey and the international expert. The newspaper has revised their agreement and signed a new one at the end of this year. They have also produced 4 investigative stories as a part of the partnership with the capacity of data journalism and worked together in an integrated approach.

A Bangla newspaper has also signed a partnership at the end of this year to produce investigative and in-depth stories and enhance the capacity of their reporters including the district correspondents.

Activity-2: Investigative Journalism Helpdesk

Investigative Journalism Helpdesk is continuing its support for the journalists this year to carry out investigation and produce stories. 27 Journalists took mentoring support over 100 times for planning and conducting investigations and structuring the report including sourcing and even storytelling. Journalists continued to reach the IJ Helpdesk to receive support in the forms of tips, resources and mentoring for their investigative ideas this year. Other than regular support, the help desk has trained a group of young journalists and students under a Fellowship.

2.1 Investigative Journalism Fellowship Programme

MRDI has organized a fellowship program on Investigative Journalism for students and early career journalists who have interest in investigative journalism. Objective of this initiative is to enhance knowledge of the participants in investigative journalism, develop core investigation skills, foster critical thinking and promote ethical practice in journalism.

A two-month intensive training programme was held, where 12 participants, including 4 females



have received hands-on training under the experienced investigative reporters and experts. The fellowship training contained a total of 16 day-long sessions at MRDI Conference Room and two virtual sessions. A certificate awarding ceremony was also organized for the successful fellows

2.2 Collaborative Investigation & Mentoring

A new initiative of collaborative reporting has been launched in this year under the Investigative Journalism Helpdesk. Though it's a common concept in the world's journalism landscape, collaborative reporting isn't existent in Bangladesh. To introduce the concept to the journalists and news outlets, IJ helpdesk started the initiative. 4 journalists from national and regional news outlets of Chattogram started their initial research for investigation based on the story pitch developed by them. The process is facilitated by the head of IJ Helpdesk through in-person and virtual interaction for story idea, process of work in a collaborative approach and planning of the story. The selected journalists are expected to produce their reports in the upcoming year of the project.



2.3 Fellowship on Data Journalism

To cater to the news media industry's demand for data journalists, an initiative of 2-month fellowship on data journalism has been launched under this activity. To select participants for awarding fellowship, an open call addressing students and early career journalists was published on MRDI's social media, in which over 270 applications were received. Among these applicants through an online written exam and interview over phone, 12 individuals will be selected for the fellowship. The whole fellowship will be facilitated by data journalist and educator Muhammad Imran. The selected fellows are expected to complete their fellowship in the second year of the project.

Activity-3: Mentorship Programme on Financial Investigation

Investigative journalism on financial corruption such as money laundering and tax abuse remained rare in Bangladesh.

Most financial journalism in the comment-based. country is heavily dependent on documents and statements, without any in-

depth investigation.

Considering this, MRDI had initiated mentorship programme financial on investigation this year. Under this mentorship programme on financial investigation, a threeday residential training took place



in November 2024 at Savar, Dhaka, where 9 journalists from leading newspapers and TV

channels had participated. Finance Uncovered (FU), a UK-based leading organization working with financial investigations worldwide has been partnered with the project to enhance the capacity of Bangladeshi journalists. FU has engaged three of their experts, who facilitated the training and supported the journalists in producing stories.

After 2-months of mentorship support under three experienced journalists as mentors, reporters investigated and produced 6 stories published both in newspapers and TV channels.

Activity-4: Reporting Boot Camp for Female Journalists

MRDI has been organizing boot camps for the young journalists from different news outlets to develop their skill and capacity in basic journalism and make them interested in investigation. This year, the project aimed to organize a boot camp exclusively for women journalists, especially the reporters, who started their careers in recent years.

A five-day residential reporting boot camp has been organized at Savar, Dhaka to strengthen the core skills of journalism, where the journalists get the chance of professional learning, critical thinking, and peer-to-peer exchange. 12 early-career female journalists participated in the boot camp to get knowledge, hands-on exercises & deep mentoring. The reporters got knowledge on basics of journalism & story ideas, planning, pitching, and data gathering, fieldwork, story writing ethics, presenting data, gender sensitivity and use of Right to Information Act in journalism.



After the camp, participants were awarded two-month mentorship under the guidance and supervision of four experienced journalists, the participants have produced 12 stories mostly on public interest issues.

Activity-5 Partnership with Journalist Association

Sports journalism is widespread and very popular in Bangladesh in terms of media coverage, and audience reach. But the sports journalists hardly conduct any investigations into the

irregularities or corruption of the sector. This year, MRDI signed an MoU with Bangladesh Sports Press Association to organize a capacity building training to enhance the knowledge and skills of the



members so that they can produce investigative reports on sports. Two-day training was held in April 2025, at the conference room of National Stadium, Dhaka, where 22 members of the BSPA participated, who work in various newspapers, online and TV channels.

Activity-6: News Media Monitoring

MRDI is operating a news media monitoring unit to track reporting trends, assess the quality of the stories and identify ethical violations particularly related to gender. The monitoring unit assesses qualitative and quantitative data on some broader themes, by scrutinizing news stories, editorials, opinion pieces, features and interviews. The team has monitored 17 national news outlets, including 7 newspapers and 10 TV channels.

The data generated from this monitoring support in identifying trends in public interest reporting, providing relevant data, analysing coverage patterns and gender representation in media. These data help to understand challenges & limitations of media for producing reports and developing project proposals and training contents as required.

Activity-7: RTI Helpdesk

The RTI Helpdesk supports journalists and other information seekers and the authorities who provide data. The help desk delivered assistance from a dedicated person via a hotline during office hours on the weekdays. The support includes identifying the right authorities, filling out application forms, handling appeals and complaints and providing expert advice on the RTI Act. This year, a total of 329 assistance was provided from the help desk to 73 individuals including 40 journalists and 33 other professionals. The support includes 30 applications, 24 for appeals, 11 for complaints and two for filing writ petitions. The help desk also provided 260 general assistances on RTI related information.

Activity-8: GIJN Bangla

GIJN Bangla has become one of the reliable sources of knowledge and information for Bangla speaking journalists since its inception. It consistently provides cutting-edge knowledge of investigative journalism including tools, methods, techniques and other resources to journalists, students, and academics. Readers can find the guides, tips, tools & techniques of modern journalism, examples of investigative journalism, fellowship, grants, and training related information to enhance the capacity of journalists.

GIJN Bangla page has published 67 translated Bangla articles related to investigative journalism and 4 monthly newsletters, which reached a diverse group of journalists and other

professionals. GIJN Bangla gave priority to cover the upcoming GIJN conference. It also published a special write-up on Best Investigative Stories from Bangladesh in 2024.

Activity-9: Online Course

The project has produced an online training course named "Basic News Reporting" for the journalists, journalism students along with the others who are interested. This course will provide solid foundation in journalism covering essentials such as reporting basics, sourcing,







story planning and structure, strategies for effective interview techniques, storytelling, roles and responsibilities of a journalist and more. Production of the course is completed this year, and it will be placed to the elearning platform of MRDI shortly after after review test run.

Journalists, especially the

young ones, who don't have access to formal training can learn the basics of journalism free of cost using this course. It will encourage and equip the learners to work effectively and responsibly in journalism.

Activity-10: Journalism Publication

IQJB project has taken an initiative to develop a casebook based on Bangladeshi investigative reports, which created uproar among the audiences and awarded by different organizations. This book will explain and analyse the details of the investigations- including the process, the steps, the context of the idea and hypothesis, method used in the investigation and the techniques used or storytelling of the report. First draft of the book is completed, and it will be printed after the review by an external expert upon his satisfaction on the fulfilment of the objective of the publication and the stories selected by the writer.

The book will be distributed among the participants of different training programmes, journalism departments of different universities, editors and journalists with an expectation that it will serve as an educational resource, create interest in investigative journalism among students, academia and news media professionals and inspire them to take the challenge of investigative journalism.

Activity-11: Gender Advocacy and Capacity Building

11.1 Launching of Gender Charter of Commitment

As a part of gender advocacy and capacity building, MRDI has initiated to develop a 'Gender Charter of Commitment' for the news media to change the existing norms and attitudes that reinforce gender role stereotypes and bring a gender transformative approach in the newsroom.

The charter was officially launched in December 2024. H E Nicolas Weeks, Swedish Ambassador in Bangladesh was present as the chief guest of the event. A total of 75 people including journalist leaders, newsroom manager, decision makers, CSO and development partners along with the working group member and MRDI team were present at the launch event.



The charter is developed considering the institutional structure of the news media and the content. 21 news outlets have signed and acknowledged the charter so far. To implement the charter, MRDI will support the outlets to develop and adopt in-house policy for an inclusive and equitable representation of the persons of all gender identities in both their organizational structure and in content.

11.2 Gender Policy Development for News Outlets

Each signatory news outlet is expected to develop their own comprehensive gender policy to comply with the gender charter of commitment, aligned with their capabilities and needs. MRDI has started to support the signatory media organizations to develop their gender policy. If an organization already has such a policy, MRDI will support them to review the document in line with the charter.

Qurratul-Ain-Tahmina, journalist, researcher, and trainer is leading the team to provide necessary support to interested media outlets. The team has finalized the concept of the policy, started meeting with the selected news outlets, and drafted the structure of the policies and finalized with the feedback of concerned news outlets. Two outlets have finalized their policies this year and 3 more will develop next year.

11.3 Mental Health support for journalists

MRDI has continued its mental health support programme for the journalists this year and provided mental health support to both female and male journalists through orientation sessions and in-person counselling. The journalists have participated to the orientation sessions and discussed about their mental health, risks involved in journalism that affects their mental wellbeing, trauma from the violences during July uprising and crisis like

Milestone air crash tragedy, mental health stigma etc. The in-person psycho-counselling support for the journalists is also going on. The mental health expert Roufun Naher, and 5 trained journalists who are working as para counsellors have delivered counselling support to 66 to journalists of which 44 are women.

The mental health expert and five trained journalists have joined in a special feedback session in September 2024 to discuss the success and challenges of the initiative and planned activity for the future.

Activity-12: Automation/Software Development

MRDI has taken initiative to transform its management and operations into ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) and to commission a fully automated software system by deploying Microsoft Dynamic 365 Business Central. One Microsoft enlisted vendor started working to deploy the system in the and continued till the last quarter of this year. The project has deployed a new vendor to carry out the automation process. This system will cover financial and accounting management, petty cash management, VAT and tax management, human resource & payroll management, attendance & staff movement management, fixed assets management, procurement management, and store management.

Activity-13: MRDI Strategic Plan Review Workshop

MRDI has organized annual Strategic Plan Review workshop in December 2024 to reflect on the organization's progress, success, areas for improvement and determine if any adjustments to the plan are necessary. A four-day workshop was organized at Sreemangal, Moulvibazar, giving emphasis on the Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability, and Learning (MEAL). 21 participants from MRDI core & project team attended the workshop.

In the workshop, participants shared their programme experiences, success & challenges in implementation and find the way forward. Special session on MEAL helped the participants



perceive the issue theoretically and programmatically as well. Recreational sessions were also a crucial part of this workshop which helped the participants in team building, fostering mutual understanding, and creating a more engaging and collaborative learning environment.

Activity-14: Reduce Gap Between Classroom and Newsroom

The project has initiated collaboration with the public universities to bridge the gap between classroom and newsroom by providing support in designing course and establishing factcheck lab in the previous year. This year the project continued the discussion with other universities to take some activities as per their requirements. Discussion was going on about the cooperation in developing course and establishing lab, launching internship and reviewing the curriculum.

Challenges:

- Lower presence of female journalists in the news outlets created challenge in ensuring equitable gender representation in the programme.

Sustainability:

- Knowledge & expertise gained from the production-based capacity building will sustain on the future production of the stories.
- Long form story telling created impact on audience trust that contributes to the business growth of the news media.
- Knowledge products under this initiative will contribute to improve quality of journalism.
